## What is Indices?

Indices is a Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) reporting platform. It offers 24/7 online access to a range of insights about the BCBSTX members you are treating, including quality and risk metrics. Its data is easy to navigate and can help you take action for members' care.

## Who uses Indices?

Indices is for care coordinators, population health managers, clinical quality professionals, physician champions and others who focus on closing care gaps and improving quality.

## What can Indices do?

The information in Indices can help:

- **Improve quality of care** for our members by identifying gaps in their care, as reflected in claims and other regularly updated data. This may include wellness exams, screenings or other preventive care.
- **Identify members' risks** for chronic conditions and the severity of any conditions

Closing gaps in members' care may help improve your overall quality performance and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Star Ratings you may be assigned.
